

COPANT organized the virtual workshop on

GREENHOUSE GASES

This workshop was held within the framework of the Regional Project on Biodiversity and Climate Change, which is funded by PTB (Physikalisch-Technische Bundesanstalt) and the experts who prepared and delivered the workshop were Verónica García (PTB Expert) and María Aurora Agulló (IRAM).

Two sessions were held, one in Spanish (March 19 and 20) and one in English (March 25 and 26). For the Spanish version of the workshop 27 participants representing 15 countries were connected, and for the English version 11 people from 8 countries were connected.

The workshop included the following topics:

- Introduction to Climate Change
- Global Mitigation Commitments
- Structure, Participants and Work Plan ISO/TC207/SC7
- Terminology in the ISO 14060 series: Definition and explanation of relevant issues, such as: Emissions Inventory, Mitigation Project, Carbon Footprint, Validation, Verification.
- Main Standards of the ISO 14060 series: ISO 14065, ISO 14066, ISO 14064-1, ISO 14064-2, ISO 14064-3, ISO 14067
- Examples of Application of Standards

- Carbon Neutrality Country Program (Costa Rica)
- GHG Programme Brazil (Brazil)
- National Emissions Registry (Mexico)
